During a biodiversity diagnosis carried out on our vineyard, the ornithologist on the lookout crossed paths with pretty great tits.

Our pebble plateau being colonized by grape worms (vine pests), this tit finds enough to satisfy its voracious appetite there (it is an insectivore in spring and summer)!!

Here is for us a precious ally to whom we offer lodging (in addition to cover): we install nesting boxes so that she stays with us for a long time.

This mission is well worth a vintage, for sure.

Wine : Vin de France

Grapes : Vermentino 80% Viognier 20%

Soil: Terrasse rhodanienne de galets roulés

Yield: 70 hectolitres par ha

Vinification : Night harvest, blended grape varieties, maceration of must, soft pressing, light settling. Low temperature fermentation.

Aging: 2 à 4 years serve at 12°C

Tasting notes : Brilliant color with green reflections. Nose of citrus fruits, white fruits. Fresh on the palate with a thirst-quenching lime finish.



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
